Four Winds is a stunning 45-foot Cruiser Stern narrowboat built in 2007 by R G Davenport, thoughtfully designed for both function and comfort. The galley opens into a spacious saloon, where a new IKEA sofa provides a relaxing spot to unwind. With a 42" TV, Wi-Fi router, and multi-fuel stove, the saloon is the heart of the boat, offering a perfect blend of comfort and modern amenities. The large windows and side hatches allow for plenty of natural light, enhancing the sense of space and openness.

The boat's exterior is well-maintained, featuring a new pram cover installed in 2021 that offers protection and extra space for the stern. A bowthruster ensures easy manoeuvrability, while the hull, built with 10mm steel, has been recently blacked in March 2023, providing both durability and protection. A well-placed inspection hatch under the rear deck adds convenience for maintenance.

Four Winds is equipped with modern, efficient systems to ensure comfort on long journeys or extended stays. The engine is a reliable Vetus Marine 35hp unit, complemented by a power supply system that includes shore power, an engine, two inverters, and solar panels. For warmth, the boat is fitted with a multi-fuel stove in the saloon and a gas boiler that provides hot water throughout the boat. The central heating system ensures a cosy environment even during colder months.

Storage has been cleverly maximized throughout the boat. The master bedroom features a double bed with space beneath for storage, while additional drawers and a wardrobe with shelving provide practical organization solutions. The lounge has a set of drawers, and the galley boasts ample cupboard space for all your cooking essentials. With batteries for both starter and domestic power, along with a galvanic isolator for safety, Four Winds is fully equipped for both convenience and peace of mind.
