Description

Mrs H is a stylish and spacious widebeam built in 2008 by Northwich Boats and recently refurbished to a high standard. Offering a wellplanned layout and modern comforts, this 60' x 10'8" cruiser stern is ideal as both a liveaboard and a leisure craft. The boat is currently moored at Shakespeare Marina, only a short walk from the historic town of Stratford-upon-Avon.

Starting at the stern, the generously sized cruiser deck provides space for sociable cruising and easy access to the engine and controls.

The saloon is a welcoming living space, complete with a comfortable sofa, a log burner for cosy evenings, shelving, built-in storage, and radiators to keep the area warm throughout the year. This room provides the perfect space for relaxing or entertaining on board.

Moving forward, the galley is well equipped with a gas double oven, a two-ring gas hob, a fridge, base units, and practical storage solutions. Instead of a traditional dinette, the galley features a modern breakfast bar that creates a sociable and stylish dining area.

The second bedroom offers a single bed with useful storage underneath, making it an ideal space for a child, guest, or home office conversion depending on the owner's needs.

The bathroom is fitted with a luxuriously large shower, a sink, and a cassette toilet, creating a bright and practical space with all the essentials for comfortable living afloat.

At the bow, the master bedroom is designed with both practicality and comfort in mind. The double bed is built around the freshwater tank and is complemented by double drawers and bedside storage, ensuring ample room for personal belongings.

Mrs H is powered by an Isuzu 55 engine with a PRM 150 gearbox, and it will be freshly serviced for the new owner.
