Description

Step aboard Stornoway, a 57ft traditional stern narrowboat built in 1997 by French and Peel. With wooden floors throughout, spacious interiors, and a practical 2-berth layout, she offers a solid foundation for anyone looking for a comfortable liveaboard or an escape for extended cruising. While ready to use, Stornoway also provides an excellent opportunity for personalisation, allowing new owners to put their own stamp on the space.

The galley is fitted with wooden worktops, a butler-style sink, and ample counter space. A gas oven and hob, along with a 12v fridge, make day-to-day cooking straightforward. A side hatch to starboard brings in light and air, while the freestanding dining table provides a simple, flexible dining solution.

The open-plan lounge features large windows that brighten the space and connect you to your surroundings. A Morso multifuel stove adds warmth and character, making it a comfortable area to relax, read, or entertain.

At the stern, the bedroom includes a double bed with storage beneath and shelving at the foot, offering practical use of space.

The walkthrough bathroom feels spacious for a boat of this size, with a pump-out toilet, sink with vanity, and a small bathtub with an overhead shower. Functional as is, it also provides scope for upgrades or modernisation if desired.

Stornoway is a well-built boat with good potential. With some personal touches, she could become a welcoming home on the water, tailored to her new owner's lifestyle.
