Step aboard Waveney, a beautifully crafted 60ft traditional stern narrowboat built in 2009 by MGM Boats. Designed with comfort and charm in mind, Waveney offers a warm and welcoming space with a 2+2 berth layout, ideal for both long-term cruising or peaceful weekends away on the water.

As you enter from the stern, you'll find a practical utility area that leads into a cosy double bedroom, complete with plenty of storage and a snug atmosphere perfect for winding down. The bathroom follows, finished with classic chequered tiles and fitted with a cassette toilet, shower, and wash basin — all thoughtfully arranged for ease and comfort

The heart of the boat is the open-plan kitchen and dinette, where traditional charm meets practical living. The galley features distinctive tiling, ample countertop space, and all the essentials for preparing meals afloat. The dinette comfortably seats four and can convert into an additional double berth when needed. Just beyond, the inviting saloon is the perfect retreat, with a log-burning stove creating a toasty ambience on cooler evenings and generous seating offering space to relax, read, or entertain.

At the bow, the well deck offers a tranquil outdoor space under a protective cratch cover — ideal for morning coffee or evening sunsets. Natural light floods in through the starboard side hatch in the galley, while the boat's generous 6'5" internal headroom ensures a spacious feel throughout.

Powered by a reliable Barrus Shire 45hp engine with a PRM 150D2 gearbox and supported by a bowthruster for smooth handling, Waveney is well-equipped for any journey. Onboard systems include heating via a diesel-fed radiator system and stove, hot water supplied by engine, immersion heater, and diesel heater, as well as a robust power setup that includes shoreline connection, inverter, and Travel Pack. A galvanic isolator is also fitted for added protection.

With spray foam insulation, solid 10/6/4 steel hull, and a valid Boat Safety Certificate until April 2026, Waveney is a solid and stylish choice for anyone looking to enjoy life on the waterways. Whether you're dreaming of quiet countryside moorings or scenic weekend adventures, this delightful narrowboat is ready to welcome you aboard.
